Following are the kinds of positions available, qualifications for each position and other general information.

SUPPORT STAFF: These are positions for at least 16 years old and a Rising 11th, 12th graders or recent high school graduates. These are all summer positions that involve participants in many phases of camp life. Support staff may live with campers and counselors and assist counselors in leading Family groups. Support staff may also have maintenance, kitchen or clerical responsibilities at camp. Support staff may assist in leading special programs offered at camp. First year Support Staff are paid \$85 per week plus \$35 per week bonus upon successful completion of contract. They will also have the opportunity to raise their own additional support for their summer of mission - up to \$100.00 per week served.

COUNSELORS: Counselors are the heart of our camping ministry staff. Counselors have leadership and supervisory responsibility for campers from the time the campers arrive until the time they leave for home. Counselors must be at least 18 years old and have completed one year of college or will be at least 19 years of age. Counselors spend their time and ministry with the campers giving leadership to a wide variety of programs and opportunities chosen by the campers. First year Counselors receive \$135 per week plus \$35 per week bonus upon successful completion of contract. They will also have the opportunity to raise their own additional support for their summer of mission - up to \$100.00 per week served.

SPECIALTY STAFF: These are leadership positions that require unique skills and expertise. Positions vary from Assistant Program Director, to leaders of outdoor adventure programs, to Waterfront Director. All positions require previous camp staff experience and most require special certification in the program area for which persons are applying. Salary is based on previous experience and expertise. They too will have the opportunity to raise their own additional support for their summer of mission - up to \$100.00 per week served.

ALL STAFF POSITIONS PROVIDE THE FOLLOWING: (1) Lodging and meals while camp is in session; (2) Worker's compensation.

ALL STAFF POSITIONS REQUIRE THE FOLLOWING: (1) A commitment to the Christian Faith; (2) Completion of application; (3) An interview with a CRM Camp Director; (4) Completion of Employee Health Examination Form; (5) Completion of Volunteer and Hired Staff Disclosure Form; (6) Criminal Background Checks as prescribed; (7) Attendance at scheduled staff training events
