How to Spend from an Endowment



One of the challenges faced by committees or stewards of endowments and scholarships is determining how much to spend each year. This seemed to be an easy process when the investment was in a 12-month CD and spending was based simply on interest earnings. But now interest earnings are slim...the current 90-day U.S. Treasury Bill yields only .07% and the one-year Treasury only yields .13%, while inflation hovers between 2% -3%. Many Churches and Trustee Committees have turned to the Foundation both for better investment options, but also for assistance in adoption of a more effective spending policy. Follow this link and you will see a real example of an endowment invested in the Foundation's Balanced Growth Fund over the past 20 years has doubled in size, yet has given away more than the total amount it started with.
