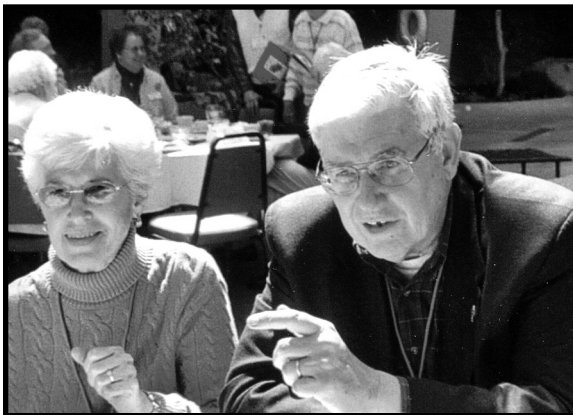
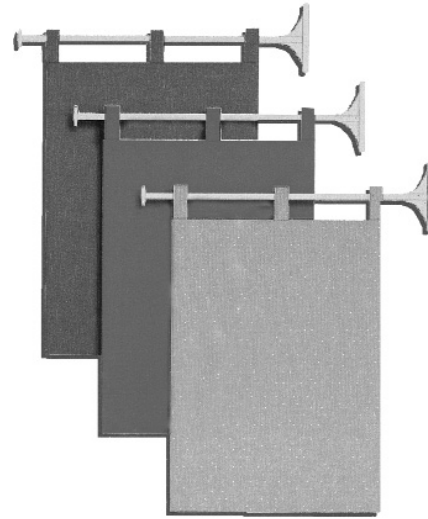

## WORKSHOP TOPICS

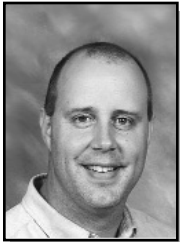
- A. Bible Study: More Provocative Parables**

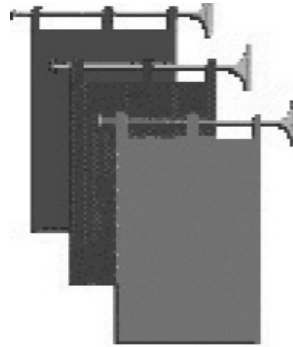


**James Rogers**
