

Teresa Fry Brown

Dr. Teresa Fry Brown is the new Bandy Professor of Preaching at Candler School of Theology. The Bandy Chair in Preaching is considered by many to be the premier chair in homiletics in the

country. Selected from a national pool of candidates, Fry Brown is Candler's fourth Bandy Professor, following Tom Long, the late Robert Kysar and the late Fred B. Craddock. In addition to four complete books, she has written articles and chapters for over a dozen more, including *Those Preaching Women, Vol. 3* and *The Abingdon Women's Preaching Annual*. A former speech pathologist, Dr. Fry Brown is ordained in the African Methodist Episcopal (AME) church. In 2010, she became the first African American woman to attain the rank of full professor at Candler.
